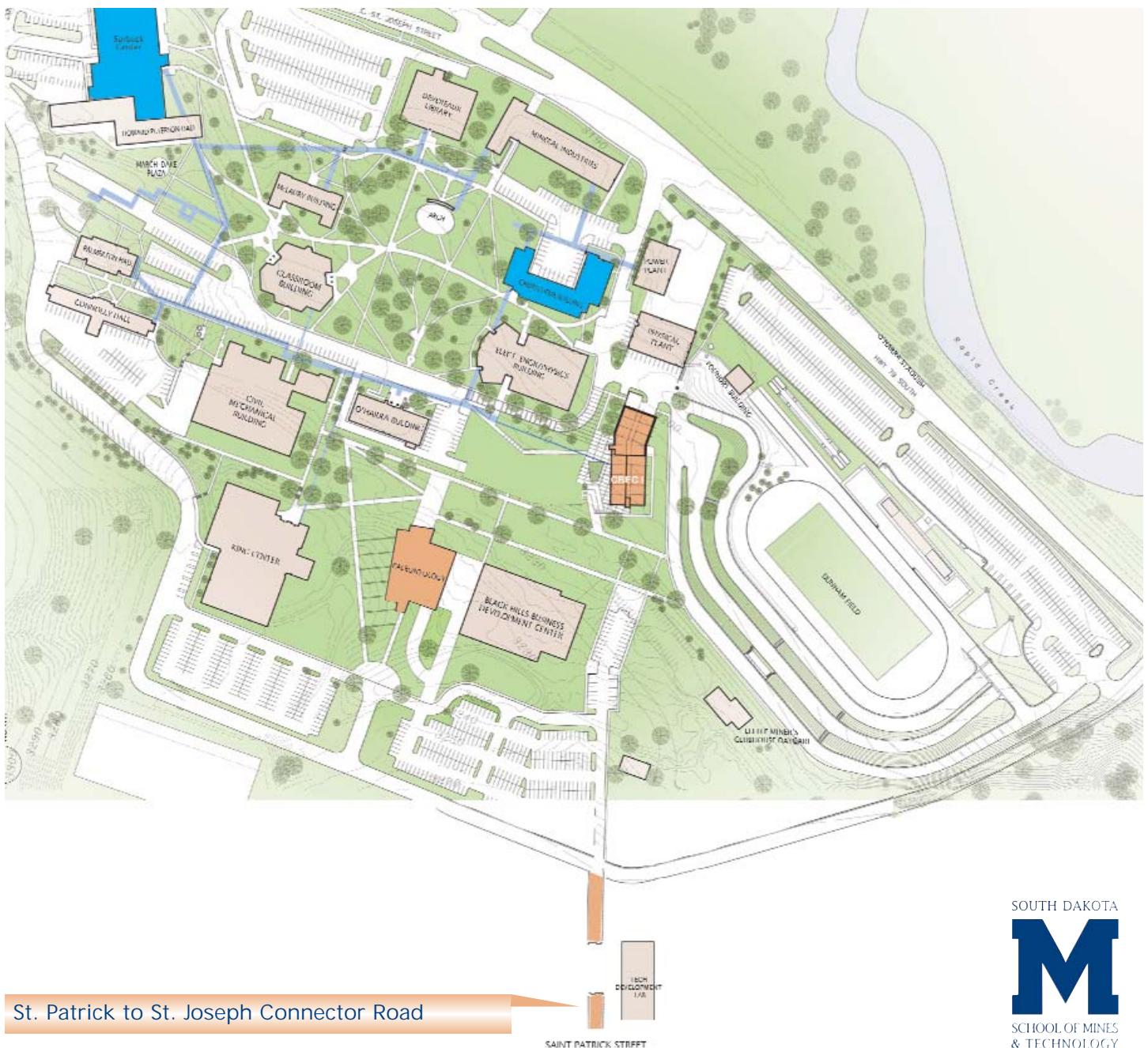


St. Patrick to St. Joseph Connector Road

- **Distance:** ~ 0.45 mile
- **Estimated Cost:** ~ \$2.5
- **Revenue Sources:** \$1 million City of Rapid City 2012 Fund; \$.5 million Federal Highway Bill; \$1 million pending
- **Why is this project important?** The road will not only connect St. Patrick and St. Joseph streets, but will also assist in the development of the southeast end of campus, providing infrastructure for future building sites.
- **What needs will this project fulfill?** The connector road will connect St. Patrick and St. Joseph streets, providing another entrance point to campus, access to the Black Hills Business Development Center, and additional parking areas. Another entrance point to campus is valuable for emergency access and to improve traffic flow during high-volume events held on campus, such as the State Track Meet.
- **Why is this project unique?** By providing better access to laboratory space and the Black Hills Business Development Center, this project has the opportunity to have a positive impact on economic development. With a unique combination of funding sources by partnering with both the city and federal governments, the connector road will not only be a benefit to campus, but to the community at large.
