

Surbeck Multicultural and Visitors Center

- **Square Footage:** 15,000
- **Estimated Cost:** \$3-4 million
- **Revenue Sources:** \$3-4 million private
- **Why is this project important?** The addition will house a Cultural and Visitor's Center, which will support the academic mission of the university by fostering a welcoming and inclusive campus environment that values diversity and a global perspective.
- **What needs will this project fulfill?** The center will serve all students, faculty, and staff of the School of Mines. The center will cater to prospective students and their families as well as providing a reception area for alumni and employers. Numerous community constituents will visit the facility for meetings and activities. The newly created space will emphasize the role that our international and students of color play in our university environment and will provide space for cultural activities.
- **Why is this project unique?** The Cultural and Visitor center will include the offices of Multicultural Affairs, the American Science and Engineering Program, Women in Science and Engineering Program, the Ivanhoe International Center, and Admissions. The APEX Art Gallery as well as a ceremonial room and cultural study/library area will also be included in this addition.
