SUBJECT: Tuition and Fees: Self-Support Tuition

NUMBER: 5:5:2

A. Self-Support Tuition

All courses offered off-campus will be at self-support tuition rates established by the Board unless state-support rates have been specifically authorized by the Board.

1) Standard Self-Support Tuition Rates: The Board sets tuition rates each March that are effective for the following summer, fall and spring terms. The self-support tuition rates are per credit hour rates for the following classifications of students:

- a. Undergraduate and graduate self-support
- b. Undergraduate and graduate self-support in Sioux Falls. This rate is comprised of the self-support tuition rate plus a surcharge equivalent to the resident tuition HEFF contribution, or 20 percent of the resident tuition rate for undergraduates and graduates respectively.

2) Remedial On-Campus Courses: These courses will be assessed a rate comprised of the undergraduate self-support rate plus a surcharge equivalent to the undergraduate resident tuition HEFF contribution, or 20 percent of the undergraduate resident tuition rate.

B. Self-Support Reduced Tuition Programs

Legislated and Board approved tuition and fee reductions and waivers apply only to state-supported courses and programs except where noted below. (SDCL § 13-55-23)

1) Reduced Tuition Benefit for South Dakota National Guard Members (SDCL 33-6-5): The self-support tuition rates assessed to members of the South Dakota National Guard will be reduced by the tuition benefit provided on state-support courses, the adjustment being one-half of the resident tuition rate. This benefit is available because the cost is being covered by funds appropriated to the Department of Military and Veterans Affairs.
